# NEWBOROUGH NETBALL CLUB 2022 INFORMATION PACK FOR YEARS 2-6





#### **WELCOME TO NETBALL**

We are delighted you are interested in playing netball. Netball is a fantastic team sport for both boys and girls. It's good for overall fitness, team building, strength and balance, endurance, resilience and so much more!

At Newborough we have a long history of being a very successful and proud Club. We represent Newborough Primary School with passion and great sportsmanship.

If this is your first time considering netball, or you're a seasoned player and parent, we ask that you please read this document carefully so you are aware of all the important information.

#### **NET SET GO**

If your child is in Pre-Primary to year 5\*, they will participate in Net Set Go - the Australian national program for school-aged netballers. NSG has modified rules (smaller balls & goals, relaxed rules etc). The program is divided as follows:

**NET** - Pre-Primary & Year 1 - this is a <u>skills only</u> program with no competition (if your child is this year level, a different information pack will be sent in week 4 of term 1)

**SET** - Year 2 & 3 - training for skills development & competition against other schools / clubs

 ${f GO}$  - Year 4 & 5 \* - training for skills development & competition against other schools / clubs

#### **JUNIORS**

Year 6 players & experienced year 5 \*players will progress to Juniors after NSG. This competition plays with full rules and full height goals and larger balls.

\*year 5 players may play in either the junior competition or NSG depending on skill level, team availability and experience. This is determined by the Club Coordinator.

#### **TRAINING & GAME DAY**

Every team has a training day & a competition day.

Training is held at school from 3 to 4pm (2:30 - 3:30 Tuesday).

Training is compulsory. As there are typically 6-7 Newborough teams and only two courts, the training schedule is determined by the Club Coordinator, taking into account coach availability.

#### **WET WEATHER**

Netball is a winter sport and is played even in torrential rain. If there is a high likelihood of lighting, PNA will cancel games – but it is very rare. Same for training – coaches & team managers (together with the school) decide if training is going ahead (training in the rain is good practice!)

#### **UNIFORMS & PRESENTATION**

All players will be issued with a Newborough Netball Club uniform. These are owned by the P&C and are loaned to players each season. Younger teams play in their Newborough tops & their own green skorts or shorts. Older players are issued dresses (or tank tops for boys). There is an additional fee for the Gilbert netball shorts that are worn under the dresses.

All jewellery (including earrings) must be removed for training and game day (no tapping is permitted). Fingernails are cut short and long hair must be tied back. Do not get your ears pierced before the season starts!

#### COST

The cost per player is \$210 including Netball Australia & WA Netball fees; PNA team & game fees; insurance; umpire fees; equipment and uniform loan. Kidsport vouchers can be used (up to \$150) for those who have a healthcare or pensioner concession card. Fees are payable upon registration on Perth Netball Association's new online system – PLAY-HQ.

NOTE: Kidsport voucher codes must be obtained by parents BEFORE completing the PLAY-HQ application form, so we suggest applying for these earlier than normal this year (we, as in the Netball Club, are no longer involved in the Kidsport voucher process).

Returning families will note the cost has increased this year. Unfortunately Netball Australia & Netball WA have added to their fees which means we have to pass on these costs (a full breakdown of costs is available on request).

#### **COACH & TEAM MANAGER \*\***

Every team needs three parents to step-up and take on the job of coach, assistant coach and manager. Unfortunately a team cannot play without parent support. From personal experience, it is a very rewarding (and yes, I'll be honest, slightly frustrating) job. But if you want your son or daughter to play.. well, you know the rest! Full support is provided by the Club. No experience is necessary. But a good sense of humour definitely helps.

#### **PHOTOS**

By nominating your child you agree that photographs of them may be taken and used to promote Newborough netball.

#### **TEAM PLACEMENT & GRADING**

For those participating in SET & Junior competitions (year 4 and above) grading will be held after school on **Wednesday February 23** to determine team allocations. Team composition change every year. Depending on year numbers, there are often mixed aged teams (which is VERY likely this year!)
